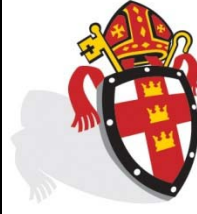

A \$50 non-refundable deposit is required for each youth participant. The balance of camp fees must be paid in full by June 12, 2010. Cancellations made prior to June 12, 2010 will receive a full refund minus the non-refundable deposit. Cancellations made after June 12, 2010 will be charged 50% of the total camp fee. No refunds are made to campers dismissed for inappropriate behavior, determined at the sole discretion of the Program Director. The Youth Ministry Office of the Episcopal Diocese of Pennsylvania retains the right to dismiss any participant if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the program and/or the participant. No participant may attend unless a completed Health History and Examination Form and Covenant have been submitted to and approved by the Youth Ministry Office.

Who is City Camp for?

City Camp is a powerful opportunity to combine mission and youth ministry for High School aged youth having completed 9th-12th grade.

What does it cost and what is included?

The price of \$200.00 includes everything except for transportation! That means housing, food, ministry supplies, devotional booklet, t-shirt and all other materials are included. Participants are asked to bring an additional \$10 for an evening activity.

When and where is City Camp 2010?

City Camp will be held from June 26th to July 3rd. City Camp will take place in the urban churchyard of St. James the Less at 32nd and Clearfield in Philadelphia.

Can our adults go?

Your adult leaders play a vital role as they serve alongside your teens. City Camp is geared toward youth, but we ask that you bring one adult for every five youth participants. The Diocese of Pennsylvania also requires that if you bring students of both genders, you have accompanying leaders of both genders. All adult leaders must have a background check prior to City Camp.

Can others from our parish be involved?

Yes! Junior High Youth groups are especially encouraged to come to City Camp and help out for a day. Adult groups from parishes are also welcome. These groups will help with food preparation and the daily running of City Camp. This is a great way to introduce your younger youth to mission and expose them to service to others.

Who sponsors City Camp?

City Camp is a jointly sponsored by the Youth Ministry Office of the Episcopal Diocese of Pennsylvania and St. Marks Church, Philadelphia.
