Good Samaritan is on the right hand side, 1.7 miles from Rt. 29.

From local points South, take Rt. 252 North to Lancaster Ave and turn Left.

Good Samaritan is on the Left hand side, just past the train station.

From Public Transportation, take the R-5 to the Paoli station.
From the station, look Right (to the West) on Lancaster Ave;
Good Samaritan is 800 yards up the road.
